### **VOLUNTEERS FOR THE CHILDREN'S SERVICE NEEDED**

As is the custom at the conference, care for children 2 years (must be fully toilet trained) through 12 years will be provided. The sisters in Jackson will prepare lessons and activities for the children. The churches in Jackson and Baton Rouge will alternate responsibility for leading the children's meetings. However, we need as many as 4 additional saints to assist in caring for the children during each of the meetings of the conference. We ask that **all attendees** be willing to serve **whether or not they are bringing children**. The ratio of parents to children is usually low, so it is not possible to meet the need with parents alone. We will assign saints to a children's session on Friday evening.

### **CARE OF THE TEENAGE SAINTS**

The Friday evening meeting is traditionally a time where the visiting brother gives his testimony of salvation and capture by the Lord. This is an excellent meeting for the young people to attend and will set the tone for the remainder of the conference. We would prefer that all young people at the conference attend the Friday night meeting. The teenagers are usually willing to serve with the younger children. We welcome their help on Saturday and the Lord's Day in groups of **two or three only**. Parents must notify the saints handling registration on Friday evening of their teenager's desire to serve before they will be assigned to help in one of the sessions.
